SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, residents of the state may purchase a physical driver license or nondriver identification card from the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency.

This bill would require the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency to offer residents the option to obtain a digital driver license or nondriver identification card in tandem with a physical driver license or nondriver identification card.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to driver licenses; to authorize the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency to issue digital driver licenses and nondriver identification cards.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) (1) Pursuant to the procedures for issuance and renewal of driver licenses and nondriver identification cards established in Chapter 6 of Title 32, Code of Alabama 1975, the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) shall issue a digital driver license or nondriver

29 identification card for a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15), which
30 may be displayed through an ALEA-approved mobile electronic
31 device.

32 (2) The digital driver license or nondriver
33 identification card may be issued in addition to a physical
34 driver license or nondriver identification card.

35 (b) The digital driver license or nondriver
36 identification card shall contain all information present on a
37 physical driver license or nondriver identification card,
38 including a bar code or other mechanism, as utilized to reveal
39 the information.

40 (c) A licensee may produce an ALEA-approved digital
41 driver license in lieu of possessing a physical driver license
42 when operating a motor vehicle or vessel pursuant to Section
43 32-6-9, Code of Alabama 1975.

44 (d) (1) Upon demand of a judge of any court in this
45 state, a peace officer, a state trooper, or any other state or
46 local governmental entity, a licensee may produce an
47 ALEA-approved digital driver license or nondriver
48 identification card, and it shall be recognized as though it
49 were a physical driver license or nondriver identification
50 card.

51 (2) A licensee may not produce an approved digital
52 driver license or nondriver identification card in place of a
53 physical driver license or nondriver identification card as a
54 valid form of voter photo identification pursuant to Section
55 17-9-30, Code of Alabama 1975.

56 (e) If the licensee displays the digital driver license

57 or nondriver identification card through the ALEA-approved
58 mobile application, the individual is not implicitly
59 consenting to allow access to or to search other contents of
60 the wireless communication or electronic device other than
61 provided for by law.

62 (f) ALEA shall apply reasonable standards of security
63 to protect the integrity of the digital driver license or
64 nondriver identification card and privacy of the licensee.

65 (g) ALEA may adopt rules to implement this section.

66 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
67 1, 2026.
