4	conform to the program or course outlined by the Department of
5	Education and which meets the requirements of this section.
6	"(b) Beginning with the 2010-11 school year, all
7	students in grades K-8 shall take physical education without
8	allowing any substitution."
9	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
10	first day of the third month following its passage and
11	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
