3 "(c) In the matter of escheats to the State of
4 Alabama, any such claim must be filed with the Board of
5 Adjustment within 10 years from the time of the escheat to the
6 State of Alabama; except, that ~~such~~ the claims of minors may
7 be considered by the Board of Adjustment if the ~~same~~ claims
8 are filed within three years after ~~such~~ the minor has reached
9 the age of 19 years.

10 "(d) The Board of Adjustment is prohibited from
11 hearing or considering any claim not filed within the time
12 specified and the limitations provided in this section shall
13 apply both to claims which have already accrued and to those
14 which accrue after July 10, 1943.

15 "(e) The Board of Adjustment shall approve a claim
16 filed by a county or a department, agency, board, commission,
17 public corporation, or instrumentality of a county when a
18 state agency has denied a request for reimbursement of
19 expenses occurring on or after October 1, 2009, required by
20 law based upon the failure to comply with an agency deadline
21 unless all of the following apply:

22 "(1) The state agency is authorized by law to adopt
23 administrative procedures for reimbursement which include time
24 deadlines.

25 "(2) The state agency has properly adopted the
26 procedures pursuant to the Alabama Administrative Procedure
27 Act.

1 "(3) The state agency has properly applied those
2 procedures in denying the claim for reimbursement of expenses
3 submitted by the county or a department, agency, board,
4 commission, public corporation, or instrumentality of the
5 county."

6 "(4) The foregoing provisions notwithstanding, the
7 Board of Adjustment shall not approve a claim filed pursuant
8 to this subsection more than 12 months after the month in
9 which payment of the claim was denied by a state agency or by
10 the Department of Finance, Division of Control and Accounts."

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective
12 immediately following its passage and approval by the
13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
