BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Madison County Commission, by resolution applicable to those areas of Madison County outside the corporate limits of any municipality, may establish a procedure by which a dog can be declared dangerous, may impose civil penalties on the owner of a dog that inflicts severe personal harm on another person, and may require that dangerous dogs, as defined by the commission, be kept in a fenced enclosure, as defined by the commission, with input from the local humane society.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional

amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 1 2 following description of the substance or subject matter of 3 the proposed constitutional amendment: 4 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, for those areas of Madison County outside the 5 corporate limits of any municipality, to authorize the Madison 6 7 County Commission, by resolution, to establish a procedure by which a dog can be declared dangerous, to impose civil 8 penalties on the owner of a dog that inflicts severe personal 9 10 harm on another person, and to require that dangerous dogs be 11 kept in a fenced enclosure with input from the local humane 12 society. "Proposed by Act ." 13 This description shall be followed by the following 14 15 language: "Yes () No ()." 16
