22	"Section 1. In Escambia County, in order to provide
23	a special fund for the creation and maintenance of the law
24	library and for the purposes of judicial administration as
25	further specified in this act, there shall be taxed as
26	additional court costs the sum of thirty dollars (\$30) in each
27	civil or quasi-civil action at law, small claims case, suit in

equity, criminal case, traffic case, quasi-criminal case, juvenile court case, proceeding on forfeited bail bond, or a proceeding on a forfeited bond given in connection with an appeal from a judgment of conviction in any district or municipal court to each circuit court or to the juvenile court hereinafter filed in, arising in, or brought by appeal, certiorari, or otherwise to the circuit court or district court or to the juvenile court in Escambia County. The costs shall be collected as other costs in cases are collected by the clerk of the court and shall be paid to the Escambia County Commission. When any part of the costs in a case have been paid, the amount paid shall first be applied to the payment of court costs provided by this act before applying any court costs paid to any other items of court costs." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
