8 To provide an income tax refund check-off for a
9 contribution to the Alabama Veterinary Medical Foundation for
10 the Spay-Neuter Program.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) Each Alabama state individual income
13 tax return form for the 2011 tax year and each year thereafter
14 shall contain a designation as follows:

15 "THE ALABAMA VETERINARY MEDICAL ~~ASSOCIATION~~,
16 FOUNDATION SPAY-NEUTER PROGRAM.

17 "Check () if you wish to designate \$1, \$5, \$10, or
18 more of your state income tax refund.

19 "If joint return, check () if spouse wishes to
20 designate \$1, \$5, \$10, or more."

21 (b) Each individual taxpayer required to file a
22 state income tax return desiring to contribute to the Alabama
23 Veterinary Medical ~~Association~~ Foundation for the Spay-Neuter
24 Program may designate, by placing an "X" in the appropriate
25 box on the state income tax form, that such contribution shall
26 be credited to the foundation.

1 (c) The Department of Revenue shall determine
2 annually the total amount designated pursuant to subsection
3 (b) for the commission and shall deposit such amount, less
4 costs of administration not to exceed 10 percent of revenue
5 produced, to the ~~county humane society located in the county~~
6 ~~in which the taxpayer resides~~ Alabama Veterinary Medical
7 Foundation.

8 (d) The Commissioner of the Department of Revenue is
9 hereby authorized to prescribe and implement such forms,
10 rules, and regulations as shall be necessary to implement and
11 administer the provisions of this act.

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
13 first day of the third month following its passage and
14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
