2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Winston County; providing for an
4 optional procedure for the renewal of motor vehicle, boat, and
5 business licenses by mail or electronic means by the judge of
6 probate and revenue commissioner; to provide for the mailing
7 fees to be deposited in the county general fund; and to
8 provide for a referendum.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. The judge of probate may transmit by mail
11 or electronic means an application for renewal of a motor
12 vehicle, boat, or business license to any person to whom a
13 license has been previously issued. The application for
14 renewal may be in a form determined appropriate by the judge
15 of probate and revenue commissioner and shall contain
16 sufficient information to adequately identify and process the
17 renewal. The signature of the licensee on the application and
18 proper remittance shall constitute sufficient authority for
19 the judge of probate to issue the license and return the
20 license to the licensee by mail or electronic means. The
21 county commission may establish a fee of up to three dollars
22 (\$3) for renewals by mail or electronic means not to exceed
23 the administrative cost of the renewals. The fee shall be
24 collected by the judge of probate at the time of issuance and
25 paid to the county general fund.

1 Section 2. Section 1 of this act shall be operative
2 only if approved by the majority of the qualified electors in
3 the county who vote thereon at the next general, primary, or
4 special election held in the county. The election shall be
5 held, conducted, and the results canvassed in the same manner
6 as the county elections. Notice of the election shall be given
7 by the judge of probate. On the ballots used at the election,
8 the proposition to be voted on shall be stated substantially
9 as follows:

10 "Do you favor the local law authorizing an optional
11 procedure allowing for the renewal of motor vehicle, boat, and
12 business licenses by mail or electronic means? Yes ____ No
13 ____."

14 If the majority of the votes cast at the election
15 are affirmative votes, this act shall have full force and
16 effect on the 1st day of October following the election. If a
17 majority of the votes cast are negative votes, this act shall
18 have no further effect. The judge of probate shall certify the
19 results of the election to the Secretary of State.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
