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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a family resource
9 center which meets certain standards and is
10 certified as a member of the Alabama Network of
11 Family Resource Centers may receive a portion of
12 funds appropriated from the state to the network.

13 This bill would require that the Alabama
14 Network of Family Resource Centers adopt rules
15 governing the allocation and distribution of
16 federal and state funds to the family resource
17 centers. The bill would also require a notice
18 concerning any proposed rules to be published in
19 the Alabama Administrative Monthly prior to
20 consideration of the proposed rules.

23 TO BE ENTITLED
24 AN ACT

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26 To amend Section 30-8-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
27 relating to the certification and funding of family resource

1 centers by the Alabama Network of Family Resource Centers, to
2 require the network to adopt rules governing the allocation
3 and distribution of federal and state funds to the centers;
4 and to provide for notice of the proposed rules to be
5 published in the Alabama Administrative Monthly.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Section 30-8-2 of the Code of Alabama
8 1975, is amended to read as follows:

9 "§30-8-2.

10 "Any family resource center within the state that
11 meets the standards established in Section 30-8-1 and is
12 certified by the Alabama Network of Family Resource Centers as
13 a member of the network may receive a portion of the funds
14 appropriated from the state to the network. The network shall
15 adopt rules governing the allocation and distribution of
16 federal and state funds to the family resource centers. A
17 notice of the substance of any proposed rules shall be
18 published in the Alabama Administrative Monthly not less than
19 35 days prior to consideration of the rules at any meeting of
20 the network."

21 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
22 first day of the third month following its passage and
23 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
