8 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
9 Alabama of 1901, relating to Baldwin County, to define the
10 Stockton Landmark District within the county and to prohibit
11 the annexation by local law of any property within the
12 district into any municipality.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. The following amendment to the
15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
16 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
17 this act are fulfilled:

18 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

19 (a) For the purposes of this amendment, the
20 "Stockton Landmark District" is defined as follows:

21 Beginning at the point where I-65 intersects the
22 line which divides R2E and R3E; thence, north to Little Halls
23 Creek; thence, follow Little Halls Creek in a westwardly
24 direction to Halls Creek; thence, follow Halls Creek to Tensaw
25 Lake; thence, follow meanders of Tensaw Lake in a southerly
26 direction until it meets the Tensaw River; thence, follow

1 meanders of Tensaw River until it meets I-65; thence, follow
2 I-65 in E/NE direction to point of beginning.

3 (b) No property within the Stockton Landmark
4 District may be annexed into any municipality by local law.

5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
6 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
8 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
9 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
10 state.

11 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
12 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
13 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
14 following description of the substance or subject matter of
15 the proposed constitutional amendment:

16 "Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment
17 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to define the Stockton
18 Landmark District within the county and to prohibit the
19 annexation by local law of any property within the district
20 into any municipality.

21 "Proposed by Act _____."

22 This description shall be followed by the following
23 language:
