"(b) Notwithstanding any authority otherwise 3 conferred by this act, after June 15, 1973, once a subdivision 4 has been approved in accordance with the subdivision 5 regulations applicable to the subdivision at the time of 6 7 approval, the Baldwin County Commission shall have no authority to impose, by amendment to any subdivision 8 regulations, zoning regulations, or otherwise, any new or 9 10 additional front, side, rear, or wetland setback requirements 11 on any lot contained within a previously approved subdivision which would increase the setback requirements or impose a more 12 13 restrictive setback requirement on the use of the lot."

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 15 first day of the third month following its passage and 16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
