13 Relating to Barbour County; to amend Section  
14 45-3-232 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize the Barbour  
15 County Commission to increase the fee for a pistol permit; and  
16 to provide for distribution of the fee.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. Section 45-3-232 of the Code of Alabama  
19 1975, is amended to read as follows:

20 "§45-3-232.

21 "(a) In Barbour County the fee for issuance of a  
22 permit to carry a pistol in a vehicle or concealed on or about  
23 the person as provided in Section 13A-11-75 shall be fifteen  
24 dollars (\$15) which shall be collected by the sheriff, or his  
25 or her agent.

26 "(b) Nine dollars (\$9) of each fee collected under  
27 subsection (a) shall be paid to the county treasury which

1 shall be used for the specific purpose of motor vehicle  
2 purchases for the Barbour County Sheriff's Department. The  
3 remaining six dollars (\$6) of each fee shall be deposited by  
4 the Sheriff of Barbour County, or his or her agent, in any  
5 bank located in Barbour County into a fund known as the  
6 Sheriff's Fund.

7 "(c) The Sheriff's Fund provided for in subsection  
8 (b) shall be drawn upon by the Sheriff of Barbour County or  
9 his or her appointed agent and shall be used exclusively for  
10 law enforcement purposes and in the discharge of the sheriff's  
11 office as he or she sees fit.

12 "(d) The establishment of the Sheriff's Fund as  
13 provided in this section and the use of such funds shall in no  
14 way diminish or take the place of any other imbursement or  
15 other source of income established for the sheriff or the  
16 operation of his or her office.

17 "(e) Effective after August 1, 2010, the Barbour  
18 County Commission by resolution of the commission may increase  
19 the fee for the issuance of a pistol permit as provided for in  
20 Section 13A-11-75, by five dollars (\$5). The additional fee  
21 when collected by the sheriff shall be deposited in the county  
22 treasury and used only for the purchase and maintenance of  
23 motor vehicles for the Barbour County Sheriff's Department.  
24 The additional fee when adopted by the county commission shall  
25 not be effective prior to the first day of the month  
26 thereafter or at a later time designated in the resolution."

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
