3 CELEBRATING THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BOY SCOUTS
4 OF AMERICA.

6 WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America, since its
7 founding in 1910, has represented the finest qualities and
8 highest ideals of our nation; and

9 WHEREAS, the goal of the Boy Scouts of America is to
10 train youth in responsible citizenship, character development,
11 and self-reliance; and

12 WHEREAS, more than 110 million Americans have been
13 members of the Boy Scouts of America and, through the years,
14 this worthy organization has produced many prominent leaders
15 in government and military service, business and industry,
16 sports and entertainment, science and technology, philanthropy
17 and community service, and every important realm of our lives;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the impact of the Scouting program is
20 especially evident in the realization that 11 of the 12 men
21 who have walked on the moon were members of the Boy Scouts of
22 America; and

23 WHEREAS, among the notable names in Scouting are
24 astronauts Neil Armstrong and John Glenn; Presidents Dwight D.
25 Eisenhower, John F. Kennedy, and Gerald R. Ford, Jr.; business

1 tycoons Bill Gates and Sam Walton; sports stars Henry "Hank"
2 Aaron and Mark Spitz; Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer;
3 filmmaker Steven Spielberg; and newsman Walter Cronkite; and

4 WHEREAS, the earliest Council formation of the Boy
5 Scouts of America in Alabama was in Birmingham in 1915,
6 marking the beginning of our great State's participation in
7 this esteemed organization; and

8 WHEREAS, under the dedicated leadership of thousands
9 of volunteers, Scouts focus on health and fitness while
10 learning the core values of citizenship, compassion,
11 cooperation, courage, faith, honesty, perseverance, positive
12 attitude, resourcefulness, respect, and responsibility; and

13 WHEREAS, the Scout Oath emphasizes each individual's
14 duty to God and country; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of a century of
17 unparalleled contributions to this nation, commendations and
18 congratulations are extended to the Boy Scouts of America, and
19 this resolution is offered in highest tribute to the members
20 and volunteers, along with heartiest congratulations on the
21 celebration of Scouting's 100th Anniversary on February 8,
22 2010.
