8           CREATING THE JOINT INTERIM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON  
9 THE EFFECTS OF TASERS ON STUDENTS.

11           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
12 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Joint Interim Legislative  
13 Committee on the Effects of the Use of Tasers on Students is  
14 created. The committee shall be composed of the following: Two  
15 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the  
16 Speaker of the House of Representatives; one member of the  
17 Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;  
18 one member of the Senate appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;  
19 and one member appointed by the Governor. The membership of  
20 the committee shall be inclusive and reflect the racial,  
21 gender, geographic, urban and rural, and economic diversity of  
22 the state. The chair and vice chair of the committee shall be  
23 elected at the first meeting by the members of the committee.  
24 The committee shall study all facets of the effects of taser  
25 guns on students in grades K-12.

26           Upon the request of the chair, the Secretary of the  
27 Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall

1 provide necessary clerical assistance for the work of the  
2 committee. The committee shall report its findings,  
3 conclusions, and recommendations to the Legislature not later  
4 than the fifth legislative day of the 2011 Regular Session,  
5 whereupon the committee shall stand dissolved and discharged  
6 of any further duties and liabilities. Each member of the  
7 committee shall be entitled to his or her regular legislative  
8 compensation, his or her per diem, and travel expenses for  
9 each day he or she attends a meeting of the committee. Upon  
10 requisitions signed by the chair of the committee, these  
11 payments shall be paid out of any funds appropriated to the  
12 use of the Legislature by means of warrants drawn by the  
13 Comptroller on the State Treasury. Notwithstanding the  
14 foregoing, no member shall receive additional legislative  
15 compensation or per diem when the Legislature is in session or  
16 if a member is being paid any other payments on the same dates  
17 for attendance on other state business. The Committee shall  
18 not meet more than six times. The total expenditures of the  
19 committee shall not exceed \$5,000.00.
