3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF REVEREND LUTHER EYER KRAMER,
4 III.

6 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow and regret that
7 news is received of the death of Reverend Luther Eyer Kramer,
8 III, of Hampton Cove, Alabama, on December 26, 2009, at the
9 age of 67; and

10 WHEREAS, Reverend Kramer was a retired ordained
11 minister of the North Alabama Presbytery; he attended Big Cove
12 Presbyterian Church and was founder and director of The Key -
13 North Alabama Center for Pastoral Counseling; he was a
14 Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist and a Licensed
15 Professional Counselor and was highly regarded for his
16 dedication and skills; and

17 WHEREAS, his educational background included earning
18 a Bachelor's Degree from Florida State University and a Master
19 of Divinity Degree from Columbia Theological Seminary; he also
20 attended Harvard Law School's Program for Lawyers in Mediation
21 and Negotiation as well as completing all requirements except
22 dissertation in the Forest Institute of Professional
23 Psychology's Doctoral Program in Clinical Psychology; and

24 WHEREAS, a leader in community affairs, Reverend
25 Kramer had been active in the Huntsville Rotary Club since

1 1991, serving as president in 2000-2001; he had served five
2 years on the Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling; in
3 addition, he was a member of the Huntsville Hospital Ethics
4 Board and a longtime supporter of the Huntsville Symphony and
5 Young Life; and

6 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death a daughter,
7 Meredith Kramer Hay; son-in-law, John C. Hay, III; three
8 grandchildren; and a cousin, Mary Anne Kramer; and

9 WHEREAS, Reverend Kramer was a valued member of the
10 community whose presence will be greatly missed by all those
11 who were privileged to know him; now therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
13 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Reverend Luther
14 Eyer Kramer, III, is recorded with deep sadness, and this
15 resolution is offered in tribute to his life, along with
16 heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family.
