3 DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE PRESENTLY KNOWN AS SHOAL
4 CREEK BRIDGE ON ALABAMA HIGHWAY 72 BETWEEN KILLEN AND FLORENCE
5 THE DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

7 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Alabama Legislature
8 to honor the service and sacrifice of America's disabled
9 military veterans at every opportunity, we are pleased to name
10 a bridge on Alabama Highway 72 in their honor; and

11 WHEREAS, those who go in harm's way wearing the
12 uniforms of the United States Armed Services engage in a noble
13 pursuit, risking all in service to their fellow Americans; and

14 WHEREAS, America's disabled veterans, who bear the
15 physical as well as symbolic scars of their service to a
16 higher good are deserving of our most solemn and heartfelt
17 veneration; now therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
19 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the bridge presently known as
20 Shoal Creek Bridge on Alabama Highway 72 between Killen and
21 Florence is hereby designated the Disabled American Veterans
22 Memorial Bridge and that the proper officials are requested to
23 place and maintain markers designating the Disabled American
24 Veterans Memorial Bridge as provided in this resolution.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this
2 resolution be provided for presentation as a memento of this
3 honorary designation by the Alabama Legislature.
