11 WHEREAS, Ms. Frazine Taylor has announced her
12 retirement as Head of Reference for the Alabama Department of
13 Archives and History; and

14 WHEREAS, Ms. Taylor, a former Peace Corps volunteer
15 and administrator who holds a Master in Information Studies
16 degree from Atlanta University, has over 20 years of
17 experience as a librarian, archivist, lecturer, and writer;

19 WHEREAS, over the course of her career, Ms. Taylor
20 has received numerous awards, including the Alabama State
21 Employees Association's Employee of the Year award; and

22 WHEREAS, Ms. Taylor is a member of a number of
23 professional associations, boards, and societies, including
24 the Afro-American Historical and Genealogical Society, the
25 Editorial Board of the Journal of the Afro-American Historical
26 and Genealogical Society, BBAAGHS, the Society of Alabama
27 Archivists, and the Board of Directors of the Alabama

1 Historical Association; she serves as President of the Elmore
2 County Association of Black Heritage and Chair of the Black
3 Heritage Council of the Alabama Historical Commission; and

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Taylor is a distinguished writer and
5 researcher; she is the author of Researching African American
6 Genealogy in Alabama: A Resource Guide; Ms. Taylor has also
7 contributed to the PBS series, African American Lives 2; and

8 WHEREAS, Ms. Taylor's long career of distinguished
9 service and achievement reflect positively on all Alabamians;
10 now therefore,
