11 news is received of the death of Mr. Ira M. Hill of Anniston,  
12 Alabama, on January 23, 2010; at the age of 87 years; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was well-known and admired in the  
14 area, having been a highly regarded businessman, the owner of  
15 Hill's Moving and Storage Company in the early 1950s and  
16 Hill's Service Company in the 1970s; and

18 1940s, he grew up in Gadsden and attended Emma Sansom High  
19 School, where he was a standout basketball player; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was a longtime member of the First  
21 United Methodist Church, the Anniston Country Club, and the  
22 Anniston Quarterback Club; he was an avid golfer and belonged  
23 to the Alabama Seniors Golf Association and the Southern  
24 Seniors Golf Association; and

25 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death his devoted  
26 wife of 67 years, Genevieve C. Hill; daughter, Betty Fletcher  
27 Hill Jackson, and husband, Robert; sister, Marie Hall, and

1 husband, George; sister-in-law, Betty Holdsambeck, and  
2 husband, Wendell; and several nieces and nephews; and

3 WHEREAS, preceding him in death were his parents,  
4 Annie Bell and Hugh Hill; brothers, Claude Hill and Bill Hill;  
5 and sister, Marguerite Harris; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was a valued member of the  
7 community whose presence will be greatly missed by those who  
8 were privileged to know him during his long and productive  
9 life; now therefore,
