3 WHEREAS, preceding him in death were his parents,
4 Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Sewell, and brother, Milton Sewell; and

6 grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend to many; he was a
7 valued member of the community whose presence will be greatly
8 missed by those who were privileged to know him during the
9 course of his long and productive life; now therefore,
