8	MOURNING THE DEATH OF THE HONORABLE CHARLIE WILSON
9	OF TEXAS.

11	WHEREAS, we note with deep regret the passing of
12	former United States Congressman Charlie Wilson of Texas at
13	the age of 76 years; and
14	WHEREAS, a native of Trinity, Texas, Congressman
15	Wilson graduated from Trinity High School in 1951 and from the
16	United States Naval Academy in 1956; he went on to a
17	distinguished stint as a surface fleet officer and was later
18	reassigned to the Pentagon as part of a special intelligence
19	unit; and
20	WHEREAS, Congressman Wilson was elected to the Texas
21	Legislature in 1961 and the United States House of
22	Representatives in 1971; he served in the House of
23	Representatives until retirement in 1996; and
24	WHEREAS, a flamboyant and charismatic archetypical
25	"Texas" character, Mr. Wilson served on the powerful
26	Committees on Appropriations and Foreign Affairs, from which
27	positions he pursued his particular interest in promoting

United States interests abroad; he is best known for his role in engineering the defeat of the Soviet Union in Afghanistan, for which he has been honored in print and on film; Congressman Wilson fought for years to increase aid and support to Afghan guerillas against America's greatest

international rival; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Wilson's vision and leadership in the Afghan affair contributed immeasurably to hastening the end of the Cold War by denying the Soviet Union's desired domination of south Asia and damaging the former Super Power's reputation for military superiority; in 1993, seven years after the Soviet defeat, 100 members of the Central Intelligence Agency, including CIA Director James Woolsey, awarded Congressman Wilson the Honored Colleague award, the first such presentation to anyone outside the intelligence service; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Wilson had since retired to

Lufkin, Texas; he is survived by his wife, Barbara Alberstadt

Wilson; and sister, Sharon Allison; and

WHEREAS, it is right and proper that all Americans honor Congressman Wilson for his contributions to victory in the Cold War and national security in general; now therefore,
