10	WHEREAS, it is a great pleasure to honor and commend
11	Dr. Sidney C. "Sid" Phillips, Jr., of Mobile, whose valor and

WHEREAS, now in his 85th year, having saved many lives and provided expert medical care to countless Alabamians, Dr. Phillips continues to be the source of inspiration to all those who are privileged to know him; now therefore,
