8 COMMENDING SCOTT GODCHAUX ON ATTAINING THE RANK OF
9 EAGLE SCOUT IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

11 WHEREAS, commendations and congratulations are
12 extended to Scott Godchaux of Mountain Brook, Alabama, on
13 attaining the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in the Boy
14 Scouts of America; and

15 WHEREAS, the Eagle Scout Award, earned by only a
16 small percentage of Scouts, involves the completion of an
17 Eagle Project and represents many years of diligence in
18 pursuit of a worthy goal that brings honor to the Scout, his
19 family, and his troop; and

20 WHEREAS, Scott received the award in a special Court
21 of Honor ceremony on October 25, 2009, at Temple Emanu-El; and

22 WHEREAS, a member of Troop 320 at Mountain Brook
23 Presbyterian Church, Scott has progressed through the levels
24 of Scouting, meeting the demanding requirements for achieving
25 this coveted award while holding many positions of leadership;
26 in addition to completing an Eagle Project, an Eagle Scout
27 must earn many Merit Badges as evidence of mastery in various

1 Scouting skills, and must strive to conduct himself with
2 honor, loyalty, courage, cheer, and service, the five integral
3 responsibilities of a Scout; and

4 WHEREAS, Scott's Eagle Scout Project, in conjunction
5 with Temple Emanu-El, involved increasing the number of books
6 read from the Temple library by the Sunday School classes over
7 the course of the school year and then permanently
8 commemorating the accomplishment by designing and building a
9 brick pathway with students names engraved on the bricks, a
10 project entitled "Pathway to Learning," and resulting in more
11 than 400 books read; and

12 WHEREAS, an 11th Grader at Mountain Brook High
13 School, Scott participates in many extracurricular activities
14 including being a pole vaulter for the track team and playing
15 trumpet in the band; he is the son of Fran and Lee Godchaux;

17 WHEREAS, through the years Scott has exhibited those
18 hard-won characteristics of trustworthiness, self-discipline,
19 and good citizenship, all components of the Scouting program;
20 with the guidance and support of his Scouting leaders, he has
21 earned the esteem of his community, fellow Scouts, and all
22 Alabamians; now therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
24 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That in recognition of his
25 outstanding achievement in attaining the prestigious rank of
