12 Superintendent of Mobile County Public High Schools; a former
13 board member of Gulf Federal Bank, he is the current owner of
14 Fast Lube, Incorporated, and received the 2002 Eagle Award
15 from the Chamber of Commerce; and

17 married for more than 40 years to Brenda Lang Marshall and
18 they have three adult children: Shawn O. Marshall, Darryl L.
19 Marshall, and Adrienne K. Marshall; he is a faithful member of
