8 RECOGNIZING APPRECIATION DAY AT ENTERPRISE HIGH
9 SCHOOL AND ENTERPRISE STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

11 WHEREAS, it is a pleasure and privilege to recognize
12 the observance of Appreciation Day for Enterprise High School
13 and Enterprise State Community College on April 28, 2010; and

14 WHEREAS, Appreciation Day celebrates the
15 collaboration that began in March 2007 after a devastating
16 tornado destroyed Enterprise High School and the high school
17 students began attending classes at Enterprise Ozark Community
18 College; and

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Stafford L. Thompson, President of the
20 College, and Dr. Jim Reese, Superintendent of Enterprise City
21 Schools, established the cooperative venture that brought the
22 administration, faculty, staff, and students of Enterprise
23 High School to the Enterprise Campus of Enterprise State
24 Community College; and

25 WHEREAS, the entire high school experience for the
26 Enterprise High School Class of 2010 has been based at
27 Enterprise State Community College; and

1 WHEREAS, each year, Enterprise State Community
2 College has invited and welcomed Enterprise High School
3 students to such events as the Fall and Spring Bash and
4 Founders Day; and

5 WHEREAS, Enterprise High School has approximately
6 1,300 students and 200 faculty and staff annually and
7 Enterprise Ozark Community College/Enterprise State Community
8 College has approximately 1,200 students and 100 full-time
9 faculty and staff annually; and

10 WHEREAS, each institution has gained immeasurably
11 from this cooperative venture; and

12 WHEREAS, with Enterprise High School now prepared to
13 move to its new campus, the 2010 observance of Appreciation
14 Day takes on a special significance; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
16 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That in recognition of
17 Appreciation Day on April 28, 2010, we honor and commend
18 Enterprise High School and Enterprise State Community College,
19 and by copy of this resolution for appropriate presentation
20 and display, we celebrate the ongoing spirit of cooperation
21 between these two outstanding educational institutions.
