1 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State Oil 2 and Gas Board. 3 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the State Oil and Gas Board, created and functioning pursuant to 5 Sections 9-17-1 to 9-17-35, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, 6 7 is continued, and those code sections are expressly preserved. Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 8 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in 9 10 Sections 1 and 2. Section 4. This act shall become effective 11 12 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 13 its otherwise becoming law.
