Section 1. (a) Any provision of the law to the contrary notwithstanding, a city or county board of education may adopt a policy to allow any person employed as security personnel to carry a firearm while on duty, subject to the following requirements:

6 (1) The policy shall prohibit security personnel not 7 certified as law enforcement officers by the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission from carrying 8 firearms while on duty in a school during school hours, during 9 10 a scheduled extracurricular activity on campus, or at any other time that students are scheduled to be on campus and the 11 12 security personnel have been notified of their presence in 13 advance.

14 (2) The policy shall require any security personnel
15 who carry firearms to have completed the firearms training
16 course required of law enforcement officers by the Alabama
17 Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission, or an
18 equivalent.

19 (3) The policy shall require any security personnel
20 who carry firearms to annually complete and pass the firearm
21 requalification required of law enforcement officers by the
22 Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission, or
23 an equivalent.

(4) The policy shall require any security personnel
who carry firearms who are not certified law enforcement
officers to obtain a license to carry a pistol pursuant to
Section 13A-11-75, Code of Alabama 1975.

(5) The policy shall provide that security personnel
 are employees of the local board of education who exercise
 judgment in the enforcement of board policies, rules,
 procedures, and the criminal laws of the state at all times
 while on duty.

6 (6) The policy shall be adopted in compliance with 7 Section 16-1-30, Code of Alabama 1975.

8 (b) This section does not require a local board of 9 education to adopt a policy to allow persons employed as 10 security personnel to carry firearms.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on July 12 1, 2010, following its passage and approval by the Governor, 13 or its otherwise becoming law.
