2	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
3	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of
4	Home Medical Equipment Services Providers.
5	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
6	Board of Home Medical Equipment Services Providers, created
7	and functioning pursuant to Sections 34-14C-1 to 34-14C-8,
8	inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code
9	sections are expressly preserved.
10	Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
11	recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
12	Sections 1 and 2.
13	Section 4. This act shall become effective
14	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
15	its otherwise becoming law.
