11	Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
12	existence and functioning of the State Board of Registration
13	for Foresters with certain modifications; to amend Section
14	34-12-4, Code of Alabama 1975, so as to require that
15	applicants for licensure be United States citizens or legally
16	present in the United States.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
19	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State Board
20	of Registration for Foresters, with the additional
21	recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.
22	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
23	State Board of Registration for Foresters, created and
24	functioning pursuant to Sections 34-12-1 to 34-12-37,
25	inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code
26	sections are expressly preserved.

1	Section 3. Section 34-12-4 of the Code of Alabama
2	1975, is amended to read as follows:
3	<b>"</b> §34-12-4.
4	"(a) The following requirements shall be considered
5	as minimum evidence satisfactory to the board that the
6	applicant is qualified to practice forestry and to be
7	registered and licensed pursuant to this chapter. Each
8	applicant shall:
9	"(1) Hold a bachelors or higher degree from a school
10	approved by the board or accredited by the Society of American
11	Foresters in a forestry curriculum accepted by the board.
12	"(2) Have passed a written or oral examination, or
13	both, designed to show the knowledge and skill obtained
14	through graduation from the school or college.
15	"(3) Have a specific record of two years or more of
16	experience in the practice of forestry of a nature
17	satisfactory to the board and indicating that the applicant is
18	competent to practice forestry.
19	"(4) Be a person of good character and reputation.
20	"(5) Be a citizen of the United States or, if not a
21	citizen of the United States, a person who is legally present
22	in the United States with appropriate documentation from the
23	<pre>federal government.</pre>
24	"(b) The board shall issue licenses only to those

applicants who meet the requirements of this section."

1	Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the
2	recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
3	Sections 1, 2, and 3.
4	Section 5. This act shall become effective
5	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
6	its otherwise becoming law
