(b) For purposes of this section, mini-truck means an imported vehicle with a passenger cab that is approximately 10.5 feet long and 4.5 feet wide, with a 600 cubic centimeters engine or smaller, capable of speeds up to 55 miles per hour.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
