8 TO BE ENTITLED  
9 AN ACT

11 To amend Section 16-5-11, Code of Alabama 1975,  
12 relating to the Commission on Higher Education and the  
13 function of the commission relating to the administration of  
14 certain funds for students at colleges and universities under  
15 certain conditions; to authorize the commission to use a  
16 portion of funds available for chiropractic scholarships at  
17 colleges and universities within this state.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Section 16-5-11, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
20 amended to read as follows:

21 "§16-5-11.

22 "(a) The commission is designated the agency  
23 responsible for those functions under the Southern Regional  
24 Compact for Education (Act 227, HJR 42, 1949; Act 40, HJR 21,  
25 1955) and those functions in Sections 16-3-32 through 16-3-35,  
26 heretofore assigned to the State Board of Education with funds

1 that may be appropriated to it by the Legislature for that  
2 purpose.

3 "(b) In addition to the function of the commission  
4 pursuant to subsection (a) and supplemental thereto, the  
5 commission may designate a portion of funds available for  
6 chiropractic scholarships for advanced education in  
7 health-related advanced education courses at the post-doctoral  
8 level at public or private non-profit colleges and  
9 universities within this state."

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
