17 To exempt the National Voting Rights Museum &
18 Institute from the payment of any state income tax and any
19 state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. The National Voting Rights Museum &
22 Institute is exempt from the payment of any state income tax
23 and any state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective for the
25 tax years beginning after December 31, 2009, following its
26 passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise
27 becoming law.
