7 Relating to Franklin County; to provide for the
8 employment of investigators in the Office of the District
9 Attorney for the Thirty-fourth Judicial Circuit; and to
10 provide the authority and duties of the officers.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. The District Attorney of the
13 Thirty-fourth Judicial Circuit composed of Franklin County may
14 appoint a chief investigator and from time to time additional
15 investigators. The investigators shall serve at the pleasure
16 of the district attorney. The investigators shall meet the
17 minimum standards for law enforcement officers and shall have
18 the same power and authority as deputy sheriffs and other law
19 enforcement officers in this state. The investigators shall be
20 paid in the same manner as other employees in the district
21 attorney's office. The investigators shall be responsible to
22 the district attorney and shall perform duties as assigned by
23 the district attorney.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
