- (4) One member from each county appointed by the state Senator representing Jackson and DeKalb Counties.
  - (5) One member from each county appointed by the state House of Representatives delegation representing Jackson and DeKalb Counties.
  - (6) The President of the Jackson County Economic Development Authority.
  - (7) The CEO/Executive Director of the DeKalb County Economic Development Authority.
    - (8) The CEO of the Sand Mountain Electric Co-op.
    - (9) The CEO of the North Alabama Electric Co-op.
    - (c) The appointed members of the authority shall serve for a term of four years and shall serve until a successor is appointed.
    - (d) The authority shall have its first meeting at the Northeast Alabama Community College at the call of the chair. The college shall provide clerical assistance to the authority. The authority may receive funding from any public or private source.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
