10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Jackson and DeKalb Counties; to
14 establish the Jackson/DeKalb Counties Industrial Development
15 Authority for the purpose of marketing and developing property
16 in the vicinity of Northeast Alabama Community College; and to
17 provide for the members of the authority and the operation of
18 the authority.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) There is established the
21 Jackson/DeKalb Counties Industrial Development Authority. The
22 purpose of the authority shall be to market and develop the
23 Northeast Alabama Technology Park on the Campbell site near
24 the Northeast Alabama Community College and other sites that
25 may be suitable for economic development in the future in the
26 vicinity of the college.

1 (b) The members of the authority shall consist of
2 the following:

3 (1) The President of the Northeast Alabama Community
4 College, who shall serve as chair of the authority.

5 (2) One member each appointed by the Jackson County
6 Commission.

7 (3) One member appointed by the DeKalb County
8 Commission.

9 (4) One member from each county appointed by the
10 state Senator representing Jackson and DeKalb Counties.

11 (5) One member from each county appointed by the
12 state House of Representatives delegation representing Jackson
13 and DeKalb Counties.

14 (6) The President of the Jackson County Economic
15 Development Authority.

16 (7) The CEO/Executive Director of the DeKalb County
17 Economic Development Authority.

18 (8) The CEO of the Sand Mountain Electric Co-op.

19 (9) The CEO of the North Alabama Electric Co-op.

20 (c) The appointed members of the authority shall
21 serve for a term of four years and shall serve until a
22 successor is appointed.

23 (d) The authority shall have its first meeting at
24 the Northeast Alabama Community College at the call of the
25 chair. The college shall provide clerical assistance to the
26 authority. The authority may receive funding from any public
27 or private source.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
2 first day of the third month following its passage and
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
