10 TO BE ENTITLED

13 Relating to Morgan County; to provide for the  
14 allocation and expenditure of money received from the  
15 Tennessee Valley Authority distributed to Morgan County  
16 pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session, to the  
17 Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County Boards of Education for  
18 the fiscal years 2010 and 2011.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law,  
21 the proceeds allocated to Morgan County pursuant to Act  
22 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session, from the in-lieu-of-taxes  
23 payments made by the Tennessee Valley Authority for the fiscal  
24 years 2010 and 2011 shall be distributed as follows:

25 (1) Fifty percent to be divided among the school  
26 systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County for teachers

1 and personnel expenses except that the proceeds shall not be  
2 expended for administrative purposes.

3 (2) Thirty percent to be divided among the school  
4 systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County for  
5 technological purposes in the schools in each system, the  
6 amounts of which shall be determined by each school system  
7 except that the proceeds shall not be expended for  
8 administrative purposes.

9 (3) Twenty percent to be divided among teachers,  
10 librarians, and educational personnel at a minimum of one  
11 hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) in the school systems in  
12 Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County. Such amounts shall be  
13 used exclusively for instructional and teaching materials and  
14 supplies, as determined by each school. Any excess funds shall  
15 be divided among each school in the respective school systems.

16 (b) The proceeds from the payments distributed for  
17 fiscal year 2010 pursuant to this act shall be based on the  
18 previous year's average daily student enrollment in the  
19 respective school systems and the proceeds from the payments  
20 for the ensuing fiscal years shall be based on the previous  
21 year's average daily student enrollment in the respective  
22 school systems.

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
24 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
