20	Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law,
21	the proceeds allocated to Morgan County pursuant to Act
22	2010-135, 2010 Regular Session, from the in-lieu-of-taxes
23	payments made by the Tennessee Valley Authority for the fiscal
24	years 2010 and 2011 shall be distributed as follows:
25	(1) Fifty percent to be divided among the school
26	systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County for teachers

and personnel expenses except that the proceeds shall not be expended for administrative purposes.

- (2) Thirty percent to be divided among the school systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County for technological purposes in the schools in each system, the amounts of which shall be determined by each school system except that the proceeds shall not be expended for administrative purposes.
 - (3) Twenty percent to be divided among teachers, librarians, and educational personnel at a minimum of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) in the school systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County. Such amounts shall be used exclusively for instructional and teaching materials and supplies, as determined by each school. Any excess funds shall be divided among each school in the respective school systems.
 - (b) The proceeds from the payments distributed for fiscal year 2010 pursuant to this act shall be based on the previous year's average daily student enrollment in the respective school systems and the proceeds from the payments for the ensuing fiscal years shall be based on the previous year's average daily student enrollment in the respective school systems.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
