20	Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 79-501, 1979 Regular

22	2008 Regular Session (Acts 2008, p. 126), is further amended		
23	to read as follows:		
24	"Section 1. Upon receipt by Limestone County of		
25	funds pursuant to Title 40, Chapter 28 of the Code of Alabama		
26	1975, (Acts No. 92 of the 1978 Alabama Legislature, approved		
27	August 7, 1978, 1978 Acts of Alabama, Page 1787), as amended,		

Limestone County will within a reasonable time thereafter,
distribute the funds so received as follows:

- "(a) Effective through September 30, 2006, all funds shall be distributed as prescribed by this section as amended by Act 86-550, 1986 Regular Session.
 - "(b) Effective October 1, 2007, and thereafter, the funds shall be distributed as follows:
 - "(1) Before the percentage formula of distribution contained in subdivision (2) of this act is applied, the sum of two hundred ninety-three thousand dollars (\$293,000) shall be distributed in the following manner: Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to Auburn University to be used exclusively for the benefit of the Limestone County Cooperative Extension Service, seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) to the Limestone County Soil and Water Conservation District, thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$37,500) to the Limestone County Economic Development Association, Inc., thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to the Athens-Limestone Public Library, five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to the Houston Memorial Library, twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) to the Veteran's Museum and Archives, and twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) to each of the 13 volunteer fire departments in the county in existence on January 1, 2006.
 - "(2) After the allocations as set forth in subdivision (1) has been completed, the remainder of all funds received by Limestone County pursuant to Title 40, Chapter 28 of the Code of Alabama 1975 (Act 92 of the 1978 Alabama

Legislature), is to be distributed as follows: Limestone

County General Fund, 25 percent; Limestone County Public

Building Fund, 10 percent; Special Hospital Tax Fund, five

percent; Countywide School Fund, 23.5 percent; School District

1, nine percent; School District 2, six percent; City of

Athens, 20 percent; City of Ardmore, one percent; City of

Elkmont, .38 percent; City of Mooresville, .06 percent; City

of Lester, .06 percent.

- "(3) Effective with the fiscal year beginning
 October 1, 2007, the three percent increase in the
 in-lieu-of-taxes payments generated by Act 2006-655, 2006
 Regular Session, to counties served by the Tennessee Valley
 Authority shall be distributed separate and apart from the
 distribution in subdivisions (1) and (2) above and shall be
 distributed to the county commission to be used for economic
 development, public service, and community projects in the
 county.
- "(4) Effective after the effective date of Act 2010-135, any increase in the in-lieu-of-taxes payments generated by Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session, to counties served by the Tennessee Valley Authority shall be distributed separate and apart from the distribution in subdivisions (1), (2), and (3) above and shall be distributed first to the following entities in the following amounts:
- 25 "a. Limestone County Economic Development 26 Association, Inc., fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

1 "b. Athens-Limestone Public Library, fifty thousand 2 dollars (\$50,000). "c. Calhoun Community College, twenty-five thousand 3 4 dollars (\$25,000). "d. Spirit of Athens, five thousand dollars 5 6 (\$5,000). 7 "e. Greater Athens Chamber of Commerce, five thousand dollars (\$5,000). 8 "f. Athens-Limestone County Rescue Squad, twelve 9 10 thousand dollars (\$12,000). "q. Athens State University, fifty thousand dollars 11 12 (\$50,000). 13 "h. Limestone County Family Resource Center, 14 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). "i. Limestone County Recycling Center, five thousand 15 dollars (\$5,000). 16 17 "j. For the fiscal years ending September 30, 2010, and September 30, 2011, based on the reduced funding available 18 for public schools, the amount of two hundred thousand dollars 19 (\$200,000) in total each year shall be distributed divided 20 21 among each school system in Limestone County based on the 22 percent of the average daily membership (ADM) of each school 23 system to the total average daily membership (ADM) of both 24 systems in the county, which funds shall be used for classroom 25 supplies, books, or technology. "Thereafter, any remaining amounts shall be 26

distributed to the county commission to be used for economic

development, public service, and community projects in the county."

Section 2. This act shall become effective

immediately following its passage and approval by the

5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
