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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 31-2-13, Code of Alabama 1975, to
6 grant a military leave of absence for members of the civilian
7 auxiliary of the United States Air Force known as the Civil
8 Air Patrol.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Section 31-2-13, Code of Alabama 1975, is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 "§31-2-13.

13 "(a) Military leave of absence. - All officers and
14 employees of the State of Alabama, or of any county,
15 municipality, or other agency or political subdivision
16 thereof, or officers or employees of any public or private
17 business or industry who are active members of the Alabama
18 National Guard, Naval Militia, the Alabama State Guard
19 organized in lieu of the National Guard, the civilian
20 auxiliary of the United States Air Force known as the Civil
21 Air Patrol, or of any other reserve component of the armed
22 forces of the United States, shall be entitled to military
23 leave of absence from their respective civil duties and
24 occupations on all days that they are engaged in field or
25 coast defense or other training or on other service ordered

1 under the National Defense Act, or of the federal laws
2 governing the United States reserves, without loss of pay,
3 time, efficiency rating, annual vacation, or sick leave.
4 Notwithstanding the foregoing, no person granted a leave of
5 absence with pay shall be paid for more than 168 working hours
6 per calendar year, and those persons shall be entitled, in
7 addition thereto, to be paid for no more than 168 working
8 hours at any one time while called by the Governor to duty in
9 the active service of the state. This section shall apply to
10 all schools and institutions of learning supported by state
11 funds.

12 "(b) Credit for active federal service. - Service in
13 the National Guard or Naval Militia of Alabama, when called,
14 drafted, or ordered into the service of the United States,
15 shall be considered as equivalent service in the Alabama
16 National Guard or Naval Militia for any and all state purposes
17 regarding privileges, honors, pay, allowances, and exemptions
18 provided by law for members of the National Guard and Naval
19 Militia of Alabama."

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
21 first day of the third month following its passage and
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
