7 WHEREAS, it is with profound sadness and regret that  
8 news is received of the death of Dr. Maurice M. Mullendore of  
9 Muscle Shoals, Alabama, on March 7, 2010, at the age of 97  
10 years; and

11 WHEREAS, Dr. Mullendore was a prominent physician  
12 and civic leader whose loss leaves a great void in the lives  
13 of his loving family, many friends, and the entire community;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, born June 14, 1912, to Reverend George  
16 Decatur Mullendore and Blanche McVay Mullendore, he earned his  
17 Bachelor of Science Degree from Mississippi State University;  
18 while serving in the United States Army, he attended the  
19 Mississippi Medical School before transferring to the  
20 University of Tennessee School of Medicine to complete his  
21 studies; and

22 WHEREAS, after relocating to Sheffield, Alabama, in  
23 1948, he served as resident physician for Reynolds Metals  
24 Company and later began private practice, specializing in  
25 surgery, obstetrics and gynecology; he was a member of the

1 American Medical Association and the Colbert County Medical  
2 Association; and

3 WHEREAS, among his many community contributions, he  
4 was a member of the Sheffield Lions Club and was active in the  
5 Masons and Shriners, where he received recognition for 50  
6 years of service; he generously supported numerous charities  
7 and was tirelessly committed to improving the lives of his  
8 fellowman; and

9 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death his beloved  
10 wife, Louise Dixon Mullendore; three daughters, Sheila  
11 Mullendore (Rick) Ingram, Sylvia Mullendore (Jim) Cofer, and  
12 Sandi Mullendore (Alex) Nelson; one sister, Sarah Mullendore  
13 Payne; seven grandchildren, Kellie Ingram-Wert, Michael  
14 Ingram, Jimmy Cofer, Missy Ingram Barnes, Bryan Nelson,  
15 Millicent Nelson Elliott, and Kate Nelson Holley; and five  
16 great-grandchildren, Hannah and Grace Anne Ingram, Trace  
17 Cofer, and Sara Kathryn and Nelson Elliott; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, he was preceded  
19 in death by two brothers, George Mullendore and Paul  
20 Mellendore, and one sister, Bea Mullendore Loheymer; and

21 WHEREAS, Dr. Mullendore was a valued member of the  
22 community whose presence will be greatly missed by those who  
23 were privileged to know him during the course of his long and  
24 productive life; now therefore,
