8	WHEREAS, it is a great pleasure to extend highest
9	commendation to the venerable First Baptist Church of
10	Talladega, Alabama, in recognition of its distinguished
11	history; and
12	WHEREAS, established May 31, 1835, with ten charter
13	members, the church grew substantially in membership and
14	services over the past 175 years and in 2010 had a total
15	membership of more than 600; and
16	WHEREAS, among the church's early outstanding
17	events, the Alabama Baptist Convention met in the Talladega
18	church in 1841 and agreed to the establishment of a college
19	(Howard College, now Samford University) which was chartered
20	in 1841 and opened in January 1842 in Marion, Alabama, later
21	relocating to Birmingham; additional milestones were recorded
22	when the Alabama Baptist Convention again met with the
23	Talladega church in 1857, 1878, 1888, and 1906; and
24	WHEREAS, in February 1932, the church moved to its
25	current location on North Street, and the first worship

1	services were held in the present sanctuary in December 1948,
2	with the three-story education space being added in 1962; and
3	WHEREAS, the church has been faithfully shepherded
4	by 23 ministers, devoted servants of God who were called to
5	lead the congregation; in addition, the church has ordained
6	more than 22 men who have served the gospel ministry across
7	the state and nation and internationally; and
8	WHEREAS, since its founding, the First Baptist
9	Church of Talladega has been actively engaged in outreach,
10	establishing three mission churches that became full-time:
11	Central Baptist Church, October 1902; Southside Baptist
12	Church, February 1954; and Northside Baptist Church, May 1955;
13	and
14	WHEREAS, in 1875, the Women's Missionary Society was
15	founded, providing education through youth and children's
16	programs and leading the church to participate in worldwide as
17	well as state mission offerings; three women have served as
18	career missionaries overseas: Gladys Hopewell, China; Jane
19	Ellen Gaines, Africa; and Edith Nunnelley Langston, Africa;

21	WHEREAS, through the years, the First Baptist Church
22	of Talladega has been a beacon of faith and a pillar of
23	spiritual strength for its congregation and far beyond; now
