8 WHEREAS, we note with deep regret the passing of Mr.
9 Samuel Lamar Adams at the age of 62 years; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams, a native of Tuscaloosa, was
11 reared in Abbeville; he was a graduate of Abbeville High
12 School, The University of Alabama, and Cumberland School of
13 Law; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams served as an Assistant Attorney
15 General during the administration of Governor George Wallace;
16 he practiced law in the firm of Merrill, Harrison, and Adams;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams was elected to the Alabama Senate
19 and served with distinction from 1975 to 1979; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams was a beloved member of the First
21 United Methodist Church; he was also a member of the Dothan
22 Elks Lodge No. 1887, Dothan Masonic Lodge No. 466, and Kappa
23 Sigma Fraternity; he was a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason, a
24 York Rite Mason, and a Shriner; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Adams was preceded in death by his
2 father, Judge Forrest Lamar Adams; he is survived by his wife,
3 Mary Earle Elmore Adams; daughter, Mary Elizabeth Adams
4 (Davis) Brock; son, Forrest Lamar (Amy) Adams, II; mother, Ann
5 Koeppel Adams; grandchildren, Weston Brock, Hollon Brock, Anna
6 Frances Adams, and Mary Hadley Adams; sisters, Julia Adams
7 (Randy) Roark and Margaret Adams (Wayne) Thornton;
8 mother-in-law, Mary Lee Elmore; brother-in-law, Albert (Lee)
9 Elmore, Jr.; aunt, Irene Adams; and special friend, Celeste
10 Hayes; and

12 family and members of the community who will remember him as a
13 man who embraced what life had to offer and returned the best
