11	joined the United States Marines in 1943 and served our
12	country with pride and patriotism with the First Marine

26	earned a Ph D in biology and served as a worthy role model

for his students as a professor at the University of

Montevallo for more than 28 years, where he held firmly to the

conviction that education is the key to success for our

nation's youth; and

WHEREAS, as an avid bird-watcher, Dr. Sledge was motivated by the love of the outdoors and spoke to numerous civic and professional organizations, as well as wrote columns for various magazines, about birds and bird-watching; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sledge's memory is cherished by thousands of Alabamians, including the members of this body, who honor his service to the United States of America and to the youth of the State of Alabama; now therefore,
