8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a person performing work
9 as an electrical contractor is required to be
10 licensed under certain conditions.

11 This bill would provide that a person who
12 holds a valid license as an electrical contractor
13 issued by the Alabama Board of Electrical
14 Contractors on or before June 30, 2010, will not be
15 required to take any examination in order to renew
16 his or her license.

22 To amend Section 34-36-16 of the Code of Alabama
23 1975, as last amended by Act 2010-540 of the 2010 Regular
24 Session (Acts 2010, p. 932), to provide that a person who
25 holds a valid license issued by the Alabama Board of
26 Electrical Contractors on or before June 30, 2010, will not be

1 required to take any examination in order to renew his or her
2 license.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. Section 34-36-16 of the Code of Alabama
5 1975, as last amended by Act 2010-540 of the 2010 Regular
6 Session (Acts 2010, p. 932), is amended to read as follows:

7 "§34-36-16.

8 "(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to violate
9 any provision of this chapter regulating electrical
10 contracting, and any person convicted of such violation shall
11 be punished as prescribed for a Class A misdemeanor.

12 "(b) It shall be unlawful, except as otherwise
13 provided, on or after December 31, 2011, for a person not
14 licensed as an electrical contractor to solicit, represent,
15 seek to perform, or perform those tasks and functions that can
16 only be performed by a licensed electrical contractor in
17 accordance with this chapter.

18 "(c) Subsection (b) shall not apply to an electrical
19 contractor who has taken an examination offered by the board
20 within the preceding 12 months, who holds a license or permit
21 issued by a county or municipal government to perform the
22 tasks and functions that can only be performed by a licensed
23 electrical contractor, and who performs those tasks and
24 functions within the boundaries of the county or municipality
25 that issued the license or permit.

26 "(d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
27 chapter, a person who holds a valid license as an electrical

1 contractor issued by the board on or before June 30, 2010,
2 shall not be required to take any examination in order to
3 renew his or her license."

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
