22	the district and circuit courts of Escambia County shall
23	collect a service of process fee of thirty dollars (\$30) on
24	each document requiring personal service of process.
25	(b) In addition to all other charges, fees,
26	judgments, and costs of court, the clerk, sheriff, or other
27	appropriate court official in the civil division of the

district and circuit courts of Escambia County shall collect a service of process fee of thirty dollars (\$30) on each document requiring personal service of process.

(c) The court official designated in Escambia County by law for the respective courts shall collect the service of process fee designated in subsections (a) and (b) and remit the fees collected to the sheriff for deposit in the Escambia County Sheriff Service of Process Fund.

Section 3. The sheriff may use the money generated by this act, at his or her discretion, for law enforcement purposes in Escambia County. The funds shall not revert to the general fund of the county at the end of the fiscal year.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
