26	"Except as electors are admitted to vote and persons
27	to assist them as herein provided, and except for the judge of

probate, the sheriff, or his or her deputy, the precinct election officials, and watchers, no person shall be permitted within 30 <u>300</u> feet of the door of the building of the polling place."

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 6 first day of the third month following its passage and 7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
