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	AN	ACT

To amend Section 36-25-7, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2010-764, 2010 Special Session, relating to prohibited offers or gifts or the solicitation of gifts for public officers, employees, and their family members for the purpose of influencing official action, to clarify that the prohibited offer, gift, solicitation, or receipt of anything, as contemplated in Section 36-25-7, must be for the purpose of corruptly influencing official action, and defining the term corruptly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 36-25-7, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2010-764, 2010 Special Session, is amended to read as follows:

"§36-25-7.

- "(a) No person shall offer or give to a public official or public employee or a member of the household of a public employee or a member of the household of the public official and none of the aforementioned shall solicit or receive anything for the purpose of corruptly influencing official action, regardless of whether or not the thing solicited or received is a thing of value.
- "(b) No public official or public employee shall solicit or receive anything for himself or herself or for a family member of the public employee or family member of the public official for the purpose of corruptly influencing

official action, regardless of whether or not the thing solicited or received is a thing of value.

"(c) No person shall offer or give a family member of the public official or family member of the public employee anything for the purpose of <u>corruptly</u> influencing official action, regardless of whether or not the thing offered or given is a thing of value.

"(d) No public official or public employee, shall solicit or receive any money in addition to that received by the public official or public employee in an official capacity for advice or assistance on matters concerning the Legislature, lobbying a legislative body, an executive department or any public regulatory board, commission or other body of which he or she is a member. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a public official or public employee from the performance of his or her official duties or responsibilities.

"(e) For purposes of this section, to act
"corruptly" means to act voluntarily, deliberately, and
dishonestly to either accomplish an unlawful end or result or
to use an unlawful method or means to accomplish an otherwise
lawful end or result."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
