Also under existing law, there 13 is no prohibition against removing or tampering with the product code on a container of soda water 14 15 or other soft drink or beverage. This bill would provide that a container of 16 17 soda water or other soft drink or beverage is 18 deemed misbranded if the product code has been 19 removed or tampered with. 20 Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama 21 of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the 22 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 23 Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general 24 law whose purpose or effect would be to require a 25 new or increased expenditure of local funds from 26 becoming effective with regard to a local 27 governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote

1 unless: it comes within one of a number of 2 specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates 3 4 funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to 5 the entity for the purpose. 6 The purpose or effect of this bill would be 7 to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, 8 the bill does not require approval of a local 9 10 governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to 11 become effective because it comes within one of the 12 specified exceptions contained in the amendment. 13 14 A BTTT 15 TO BE ENTITLED 16 AN ACT 17 To add Section 20-1-25.1 to the Code of Alabama 1975 18 to prohibit the removal of or tampering with the product code 19 on a container of soda water or other soft drink or beverage 20 21 and to provide criminal penalties therefor; and in connection 22 therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement 23 of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the 24 meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 25 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official 26 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as 27 amended.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 20-1-25.1 is added to the Code of
Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

4 §20-1-25.1.

A container of soda water or other soft drink or
beverage shall be deemed misbranded if the product code on the
container has been removed or tampered with.

Section 2. Although this bill would have as its 8 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 9 10 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further 11 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 12 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 13 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an 14 15 existing crime.

16 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 17 first day of the third month following its passage and 18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
