25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Sections 11-44E-41 and 11-44E-71 of the
27	Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

2 "Any person desiring to become a candidate in any election for the office of commissioner may become such 3 candidate by filing in the office of the city clerk a 5 statement in writing of such candidacy accompanied by a petition signed by a minimum of fifty registered voters of 6 7 such commission district or in the case of mayor, one hundred registered voters of the municipality, endorsing the candidacy 8 9 of such candidate and an affidavit taken and certified by such city clerk or notary public. Such statement shall be filed by 10 5:00 P.M. on the first fourth Tuesday in June preceding the 11 12 date set for the election and shall be substantially in the following form: 13 ""State of Alabama, ____ County. I, the 14 15 undersigned, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am a citizen of the City of , in said State and County, and 16 reside at _____ in said City of _____, that I desire to become 17 a candidate for the office of commissioner for District , 18 in said City at the election for said office to be held on the 19 20 ____ day of ___ and that I am duly qualified to hold said office if elected thereto, and I hereby request that my name 21 22 be printed upon the official ballot at said election. "Signed ; 23 "Sworn to and subscribed before me on this day 24 of , 2 , and filed in this office for record on said 25 26 day. _____ City Clerk." 27

"Said statement shall be accompanied by a qualifying fee in the amount of \$150.00 for candidates for a commissioner, which fee shall be paid over by the city clerk to the general fund of the city. Any person may file with the city clerk, a verified pauper's oath that he (she) does not have the financial resources to pay a qualifying fee and thereupon shall be exempt from filing such fee. No name shall appear upon said ballot as a candidate for election except the names of such persons as have become candidates according to provisions as above set forth. No primary election shall be held for the nomination of candidates for the office of mayor or commissioner and candidates shall be nominated only as hereinabove described.

"Any person desiring to become a candidate at any election for the office of mayor may become such candidate by filing in the office of the city clerk a statement in writing of such candidacy, accompanied by a petition signed by a minimum of 100 registered voters of such city endorsing the candidacy of such candidate and an affidavit taken and certified by such city clerk or by a notary public that such person is duly qualified to hold the office for which he (she) desires to be a candidate. Such statement shall be filed by 5:00 p.m. on the first fourth Tuesday in June preceding the day set for such election and shall be in substantially the following form:

"State of Alabama, County. I, the undersigned, 1 2 being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am a citizen of the City of , in said State and County, and reside at 3 in said City of , that I desire to become a candidate for the office of mayor in said City at the election 5 for said office to be held on the day of and that 6 7 I am duly qualified to hold said office if elected thereto and I hereby request that my name be printed upon the official 8 ballot at said election. 9 "Signed ; 10 "Sworn to and subscribed before me by said on 11 this day of _____ 2__, and filed in this office for record on 12 said day , City Clerk." 13 14 "Said statement shall be accompanied by a qualifying 15 fee in the amount equal to \$300.00 which qualifying fee shall 16 be paid over by the city clerk to the general fund of the city. Any person may file with the city clerk, a verified 17 pauper's oath that he (she) does not have the financial 18 19 resources to pay a qualifying fee and thereupon shall be 20 exempt from filing such fee. No names shall appear upon said ballot as a candidate for election except the names of such 21 22 persons as have become candidates according to provisions of 23 this chapter." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 24 first day of the third month following its passage and 25 26 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
