To amend Section 38-3-1, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the Department of Senior Services, to remove language prohibiting no two of the three at-large members of the board of directors from having the same religious faith.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 38-3-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

10 "\$38-3-1.

"There is hereby created the Department of Senior Services of the State of Alabama, which shall be under the direction and control of a board of directors which shall consist of 16 members. The board shall be composed of two members of the Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate; two members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House; the Commissioner of the State Department of Labor, the State Health Officer, and the Commissioner of the State Department of Human Resources as ex officio members; and nine members to be appointed by the Governor for terms concurrent with the term of the Governor. Of the members appointed by the Governor, one shall be a representative of labor, one shall be a representative of the medical profession, three shall be representatives of senior citizen
