"Every applicant for an original license issued 1 under this chapter shall file a written application with the 2 board in such form and containing such information as the 3 board may prescribe, which shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable filing fee of \$50.00 one hundred dollars (\$100), 5 and by the appropriate license fee as prescribed by this 6 7 chapter, together with the amount or amounts of the prescribed license fee or fees, if any, levied or imposed by the county 8 governing body." 9 10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 11 first day of the third month following its passage and 12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
