2 ENROLLED, An Act,

To amend Section 41-16-60 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to prohibiting members or officers of certain public offices or positions from participating in the public competitive bid process; to provide that a member or officer having a financial interest in a publicly bid contract may participate in the public bid process if either the proposed contract was created before an individual begins serving in a public position, or the individual does not participate in the decision-making process regarding a proposed public contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 41-16-60 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$41-16-60.

"No member or officer of the said Members and officers of the state trade schools, state junior colleges, state colleges and universities under the supervision and control of the State Board of Education, the city and county boards of education, the district boards of education of independent school districts, the county commissions and the governing boards of instrumentalities of the state and the governing boards of instrumentalities of counties and municipalities, including waterworks boards, sewer boards, gas boards and other like utility boards and commissions, shall

1	<u>may</u> be financially interested <u>in</u> or have any personal		
2	beneficial interest, either directly or indirectly, in the		
3	purchase of or contract for any personal property or		
4	contractual service, nor shall any person willfully make any		
5	purchase or award any contract in violation of the provisions

7	"(1) The contract or agreement under which the		
8	financial interest arises was created prior to the election or		
9	appointment of the individual to the position he or she holds.		
10	"(2) The individual holding the position does not		
11	participate in, by discussion or by vote, the decision-making		
12	process which creates the financial or personal beneficial		
13	<u>interest.</u>		
14	"Any violation of this section shall be deemed a		
15	misdemeanor, and any person who violates this section shall,		
16	upon conviction, be imprisoned for not more than 12 months or		
17	fined not more than \$500.00 or both. Upon conviction thereof,		
18	any person who willfully makes any purchase or awards any		
19	contract in violation of the provisions of this article shall		
20	be removed from office."		
21	Section 2. This act shall become effective		
22	immediately following its passage and approval by the		
23	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
